THE SUDAN PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2009

(Amendment No.1)

In accordance with the provisions of Article 59(2) (b) read together with Article 85(1) of the Interim Constitution of Southern Sudan, 2005, the Southern Sudan Legislative Assembly, with the assent of the President of the Government of Southern Sudan, hereby enacts the following:

1. Title and Commencement.

This Act may be cited as "The Sudan People's Liberation Army (Amendment) Act, 2009" and shall come into force on the date of its signature by the President.

2. Purpose.

The purpose of the Act is to amend Section 16 (1) of the Sudan People's Liberation Army Act, 2009.

3. Amendment of Section 16 (1) of the Act.

(1) Section 16 (1) of the Sudan People's Liberation Army Act, 2009 is amended as follows :-

- (a) Delete the phrase "a non-uniformed person" between "be" and "assisted" in the first line.
- (b) Delete the phrase "a civilian" between "by" at the end of the first line and "Undersecretary" in the second line.

(2) Section 16 (1) to read as follows:-

"The Minister shall be assisted by an Undersecretary"
